On October 3, 2024, the Central Cabinet of India granted classical language status to Bengali and Assamese in recognition of their ancient heritage. This is a matter of great pride for us. In this regard, the Assam government has directed that from November 3 to November 9, a week of Language Pride (Bhasha Gaurav Saptaho) will be celebrated with honor, focusing on the promotion and spread of Bengali and Assamese, along with all other languages spoken in Assam.

In line with the Assam government's directive, Karimganj College has organized a discussion session to observe this week. Prof. Dr. Bishwatosh Choudhury from the Department of Bengali, Assam University, will be the key speaker for the program. Dr. Govind Sarma, Associate Professor in the Department of Sanskrit, will deliver a talk on the ancient language of Sanskrit. Dr. Sujit Tewari from the Department of Physics will deliver a lecture in Hindi, and Ms. Rani Duarah from the Department of English will speak on the Assamese language.

In accordance with the Assam government's directive for the observance of Language Pride Week, the Bengali Department of Karimganj College has organized several competitions for students. Students from any department of Karimganj College are eligible to participate in these competitions. The guidelines and rules for the various competitions are outlined below. All competitions will be conducted online. The winners of the competitions will be awarded during the central event of Language Pride Week organized by Karimganj College on November 9.

Competitions:

1. Spelling Competition (Bengali)

(100 words will be provided, and participants must select the correct spelling. The time limit is 30 minutes. The competition link will open and close at the scheduled time. Students must submit their answers online within the given time. The competition will be held on November 7 at 12:30 PM. The link will be provided on the college website.)

2. Quiz Competition on Bengali Language and Literature

(50 questions will be provided. The time limit is 30 minutes. The competition link will open and close at the scheduled time. Students must submit their answers online within the given time. The competition will be held on November 8 at 12:30 PM. The link will be provided on the college website.)

3. Essay Writing Competition

Topic: The Importance and Necessity of the Mother Tongue (within 1000 words, article should be written in Bengali)

4. Poetry and Short Story Competition (Bengali)

5. Slogan Writing Competition (Bengali)

(For the Essay, Poetry & Short Story, and Slogan competitions, participants must email their submissions to the department's email by 11:30 AM on November 8. The email subject must include the name of the competition, and the participant's name, class, roll number, and mobile number must be mentioned at the end of the submission.
