3. Structure of the Assignment

The assignment must be organized in the following format:

a) Introduction

Provide a brief background of the topic and explain the purpose and scope of the assignment.

b) Main Discussion

Present a detailed explanation of the topic with proper headings and sub-headings. The discussion should be clear, logical, and well-organized.

c) Conclusion

Summarize the main points discussed and provide a clear concluding statement.

4 Word Limit

The assignment should be approximately 1500 words.

5 Submission

Submit the assignment on or before the given deadline.
